

BIO MEDICAL WASTE AUTHORIZATION CERTIFICATE

UNDER BIO MEDICAL WASTE RULES,2016.

1. M/s :Jhajjar Power Limited an occupier or operator of the facility located at Village - Khanpur, Tehsil- Matenhail, is hereby granted an authorisation for; Generation, segregation, Collection
2. M/s Jhajjar Power Limited is hereby authorized for handling of Biomedical Waste as per the capacity given below:

3. This authorisation shall be in force for a period of 01/04/2019 To 31/03/2024 Year from the date of issue.

4. This authorisation is subject to the condition stated below and to such other condition as may be specified in the rules for the time being in force under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.

TERMS & CONDITIONS OF AUTHORISATION:-

1. The applicants shall comply with the provisions of Bio-Medical Waste Management Rules 2016 notified vide No.S.O. 630(E) dated 20th July,2016
2. Bio-Medical Waste shall be treated & disposed off in Compliance with the standards prescribed in Schedule 1.
3. Every occupier where required shall setup in accordance with the time schedule-IV, requisite treatment Bio-Medical Waste treatment facilities like incinerator,autoclave,microwave system for the treatment of the waste at a common waste treatment facility or any other waste treatment facility.
4. Bio-Medical Waste shall not be mixed with any other waste.
5. Bio-Medical Waste shall be segregated into containers/bags at appoint of generation with Shedule-II prior to its storage, transportation,treatment & disposal.The containers shall be labeled according to Schedule-II
6. If a container is transported from the premises where Bio-Medical Waste is generated to any waste treatment facility outside the premises where Bio-Medical Waste is generated to any waste treatment facility outside the premises, the container shall apart from the label prescribed in schedule III, also carry information according to Schedule IV.
7. Notwithstanding anything contains in Motors Vehicle Act, 1995 or rules there under, untreated the Bio-medical Waste shall be transported only in such vehicle as may be authorised for the purpose by the competent authority as specified by the Govt.
8. No untreated Bio-Medical Waste Shall be kept stored beyond a period of 48 hours.
9. Every authorised person shall maintain records related to the generation, collection, reception, storage, transportation, treatment disposal of Bio-Medical Waste in accordance with those rules & any guideline issued.
10. All records shall be subject to inspection & verifications by the prescribed authority at any time.
11. Suitably designed pollution control devices should be installed/retrofitted with the incinerator to acheive the above emission limits, if necessary.
12. Waste to be incinarated shall not be chemically treated with any chlorinated disinfectants.
13. Chlorinated plastics shall not be incinarated.Toxic metals in incinaration ash shall be limited with the regulatory quantities as defined under the Hazardous Waste Management Rules, 2016.
14. Only low sulphur fuel like L.D.O/L.S.H.S/Deisel shall be used as fuel in the incinarator.
15. Occupier will comply all direction for generation, collection, reception, storage, transportation, treatment, disposal as per Bio-Medical Waste Management Rules 2016 & will ensure that there is no adverse effect to human & Environment.
16. The occupier will segregate the Bio-Medical Waste at the point of generation in accordance with the special-II of Bio-Medical Waste Management Rules, 2016.
17. The authorization would be subject/having proper disposal system for Bio-Medical Waste.

18. The unit shall maintained a log Book for suggestion/collection of Bio-Medical Waste at the source (i.e.wards) and also for each category of waste i.e.incineration, autoclaving or landfill etc.
19. The yellow Bags should be non chlorinated bags.
20. The every occupier will also submit the copy of agreement every year before 30th April from any authorised services provider.

Conditions:

- 4.The authorization is granted for 07 beds with the condition that the HCF will got renewed the agreement with the service provider on yearly basis and submit the copy of the same to board.
2. HCF shall apply for obtaining consent to operate and will submit analysis report of the STP .
- 3.The HCF will submit the annual return on yearly basis.
- 4.The HCF will comply with the provisions of BMW rules,2016 and submit compliance report accordingly to board.
- 5.The HCF will initially do the disinfection/neutralization of the trade effluent before discharging the same in STP as per the provisions of BMWM rules,2016.

SERVICE AGREEMENT

The Agreement is entered into on this 1st Day of April 2020 at Haryana.

BY AND BETWEEN

M/s S D Bio Medical Waste Management Co. having its treatment facility at VPO Baland, Distt Rohtak, Haryana and its regd. office at VPO Baland, Distt. Rohtak, Haryana, (hereinafter referred to as "First Party" which expression shall, unless contrary to and/or repugnant to the context mean and include it's successors, representatives and permitted assigns) through Sh. Sumit Nandal to enter into and sign this agreement for and on behalf of the First Party.

AND

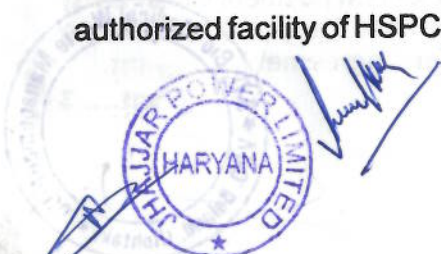
M/s Shrija Power Ltd. (Hereinafter referred to as "Second Party" which expression shall, unless contrary to and / or repugnant to the context mean and include its successors, representatives and permitted assigns) through its authorized representative of the Second Party.

WHEREAS

The First Party has been authorized by the Haryana State Pollution Control Board (HSPCB) of the Bio-Medical Waste Rules, 2018 for operating a facility for the Collection, Reception, Transportation, Treatment and Disposal of Bio-Medical Waste in Haryana.

The Second Party in compliance of the Bio-Medical Waste (Management & Handling) Rules, 2018 desired to have services for disposal of their Bio-Medical Waste for which the First Party is authorized facility of HSPCB

NOW THIS AGREEMENT witnessed the following terms & conditions to be performed by both the parties to the agreement.

1. The First Party will require the Second Party's staff/representative to sign its Daily BMW Collection Sheet in acknowledgement of Bio-Medical Waste handed over. The First Party's Staff will sign the Record Book to be maintained by the Second Party in acknowledgement of waste collected. Maintenance of the said Record Book by the Second Party is a statutory requirement and has to be complied with.
2. The Second Party will arrange collection, and ensure proper segregation of Bio-medical Waste generated from its various department/wards, as per Bio-medical Waste (Management & Handling) Rules, 2018. The Second Party also ensures that all the Bio Medical Waste i.e. incinerable and autoclavable waste (including plastic waste) is handed over to First Party. All infected material including culture plates, laboratory sample (autoclavable) shall be segregated in yellow bags at user level and given to First Party.
3. The Second Party will pack the segregated Bio-Medical as per rules, at the collection end point, in Colour Coded Bags, Label the said bags as per Schedule IV (Rule 6) of the Bio- Medical Waste Rules, 2018 and keep them ready for collection by First Party's collection staff during 6 a.m. to 10 p.m. or any other time which may be mutually agreed upon.
4. **The Second Party will itself arrange for all color-coded bags as per BMW Rules to be used for internal segregation & for their end point purposes.**
5. The Second Party undertakes to deliver to the First Party only the segregated Bio-Medical Waste generated on daily basis. Bags should be duly labeled as per Schedule IV, signed and tagged General Waste i.e. (MUNICIPAL SOLID WASTE IS NOT TO BE PUT INTO THE COLOUR CODED BAGS AT ALL). For any violation of the Bio-Medical Rules in this regard the Second Party shall be exclusively responsible.
6. The Second Party's responsibility will cease once the segregated bio-medical waste, duly packed, labeled and signed, has been handed over to the First Party. It is specifically agreed and understood that compliance of the Bio-medical Waste (Management & Handling) Rules 2018 during transportation and disposal of Bio-Medical Waste shall be the exclusive responsibility of the First Party. The Second Party will be solely responsible for compliance of Bio-Medical Waste Rules, 2018 in respect of their liquid bio-medical waste.
7. The First Party will charge the Second Party being a Hospital having Bed facilities, Rs. 29,000/- (Twenty Nine thousand only) Monthly subject to maximum quantum of Kg. BMW collected in excess of agreed quantity will be charged @ Rs. Per Kg extra. Monthly charges are payable at the time of signing of agreement and service tax will be chargeable over and above the agreement amount as per government rules.
8. Apart from one month charges payable at the time of signing of agreement as per clause 7 above, the late fee Rs. 200 per month, in which the payment is due, would be charged by the First Party if payment is not made within 10 day of the receipt of the bills or 10th of every month, whichever is earlier.
9. **Payment will be accepted only by Cheque /NEFT/RTGS. CASH PAYMENT WILL BE NOT ACCEPTED IN ANY CIRCUMSTANCE. If any payment made in CASH it will not be acknowledged by the Company.**
10. Taxes, such as Contract Sales Tax, Service Tax etc., if applicable, shall be payable by the Second Party.
11. (a) Notwithstanding the aforesaid terms this Agreement may be terminated by either party by giving 90 days written notice. However this requirement of 90 days notice shall not be applicable upon the occurrence of any of events specified in Clause 10 b (i), in which events the service would be suspended/ terminated forthwith
(b) Notwithstanding the aforesaid term:
 - i. The First Party will be within their rights to suspend the services to the Second Party in the event of the Second Party handing over un-segregated Bio-Medical Waste or for non payment within Thirty days of submission of the bill. After termination of agreement the First Party shall inform the Haryana State Pollution Control Board in writing regarding cancellation of agreement.



12. Neither party shall transfer or assign the right granted under this Agreement without the prior intimation to and permission of the other party without obtaining a written undertaking by the proposed assignee/transferee agreeing to assume all of the said party's obligations under this Agreement and to abide by all the obligations and covenants contained herein.
13. In the event of any increase in the prices of diesel, petrol, CNG, electricity etc. or in minimum wages payable to employees as per Minimum Wages Act of any other circumstances that affect the transportation/disposal cost of Bio-Medical Waste during the substance of this agreement, the First Party shall be entitled to enhance rates as prescribed in clause 8, which shall be fixed by mutual agreement between the parties.
14. No change of modification or waiver of any of the terms of this Agreement shall be effective unless agreed to in writing and signed by a duly authorized officer of each of the parties hereto.
15. This agreement shall be governed by the laws of India and shall be interpreted and construed in accordance with the laws of India and the Courts at Ambala, Haryana alone shall have exclusive jurisdiction to try, entertained and dispose of any dispute between the parties hereto.
All notices, requests, demands and other communications required/permitted to be given under this Agreement shall be in writing and delivered by hand against receipt, or sent by registered mail or by telex at the following address.

16. The term of this Agreement shall be commencing from 01/04/2020 and terminating on 31/03/2021 and the Agreement thereafter may be renewed for such further period and on such terms and conditions as may be mutually decided by the parties.
